## PARK TERRACE MUTUAL HOUSING Affordable Family Housing



Park Terrace Mutual Housing was Mutual Housing Association of Greater Hartford's first rental property, acquired in 1988. The 42 units in 7 contiguous buildings facing Pope Park have provided homes for low-income families and individuals ever since.

Park Terrace Mutual Housing was originally purchased and rehabbed in 1988 under the State's Mutual Housing program. However, by 2013, it was apparent that a large rehabilitation was needed. Park Terrace Mutual Housing was awarded funding through the Competitive Housing Assis-

tance for Multifamily Properties to upgrade Park Terrace and make it sustainable for another 20 years. The renovations have allowed Park Terrace to become modern and green while pre-



serving the historic character of the buildings.

Located in Frog Hollow across from Pope Park, two blocks from Park Street and the shopping plaza, and a short distance from Trinity College, Park Terrace Mutual Housing is ideally situated among public amenities, jobs, and transportation.
